

Summary of TSA Council/Committee Day held on 25th April 2018

- Council welcomed the newly elected Lucy Powers of Powers & Tiltman to Council and the PR Committee.
- The SmartWater initiative was announced to TSA Members on 5th February which has resulted in a big response. The first SmartWater briefing was distributed to Members on 5th April.

- Membership stands at 182 companies
