



Summary of TSA Council meeting held on 20th April 2016

- TSA has a joint stand with RICS, ICES, AGI and ICE at the GEO Business Show (24th & 25th May at the Business Design Centre in Islington). TSA will also be holding a Workshop at 11.45am on the second day of the Show on the subject of stolen equipment.
- The results of the CSCS Cards poll have been shared with the Scheme Operators, with a view to meeting at GEO Business to discuss further.
- TSA's AGM (13th April) was well received by members, with a record attendance on the day.
- Eight Membership Applications are currently being processed.
- Membership stands at 168 companies.
- Various seminar topics are in the pipelines for the rest of the year – including Marketing/IT and also breakfast meetings on NEST, succession planning and financial planning.
